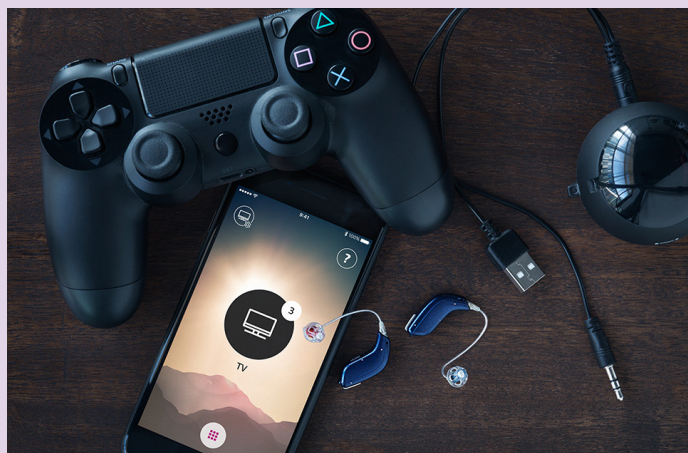

Above: Many hearing assisted devices can be controlled via Bluetooth or your Smart Phone. With a program App to control settings, children and teenagers are able to stream audio, listen to music, watch videos or make phone calls without any disruption. The App can also connect to devices – like a TV - using a transmitter box.

If a permanent hearing loss is identified, hearing aids or other amplification devices are often recommended regardless of age.

A range of hearing devices are fit at our Center as well as special Bluetooth devices that connect wirelessly to the hearing aids for enhanced communication in the classroom, watching television and streaming from a phone or computer.

About your Child's Hearing:

The development of hearing in pediatric patients is critical. Reduced hearing can cause problems with speech and language development, listening, learning, behavior or social skills. Your child's hearing should be evaluated if you child is speaking differently, or not speaking at all, when compared to other children of the same age. As an infant, if your child does not respond to sounds or voices, their hearing should be evaluated as soon as possible. Your child's Primary Care Physician or Pediatrician can refer you to our Audiology Center.
